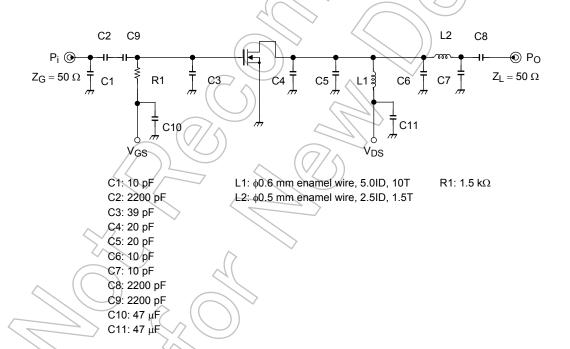

Output Power Test Fixture

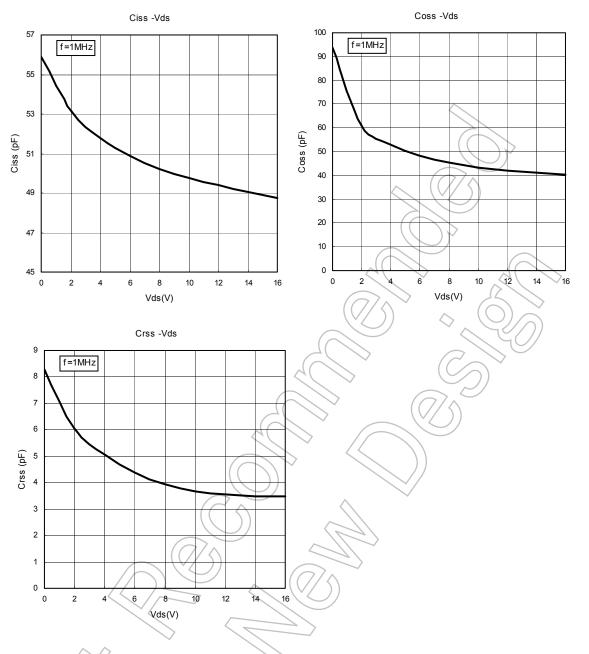
